

Forming Questions

Basic Question Types

There are 3 different kinds of questions:



1. **'Yes/No questions'** (the answer to the question is "Yes." or "No.")
2. **'Question Word' questions** (the answer to the question is "information")
3. **Choice questions** (we must choose the answer)

1. Yes/No questions (short questions and short answers)

- **Answer:** The student is at school.
- Now make the question.

1. Start with: '**Where**'
 2. Then write: '**is**' (am, are, can etc.) + **the student**
 3. Add a **question mark = ?**
- } Question: Where is the student?

Attention:

Answer: The student who is a good football player is at school.
Question: Where is the student who is a good football player?

Answer:

"I am **from Belgium.**"

"He is **from America.**"

"She is **from Thailand.**"

"It is **from Malaysia.**"

When there are no auxiliaries like: 'is' 'am', 'are', you have to add a form of 'to do'.

I work in my garden. Question: Where **do** you work?

She works in her garden. Question: Where **does** she work?

We work in our garden. Question: Where **do** you work?

They play the flute in the temple garden. Question: Where **do** they play the flute?

6. 'Why' questions

In the answer we give a reason for something. 'Reason' is the cause of an event or action.

How to make 'Why questions'

1. Start with 'Why.'
2. Then write the auxiliary verb (is, am, are, can, etc.).
3. Finally: add the rest of the sentence. (When there is no auxiliary verb, use 'to do')

In the answer you use 'because'.

Why do you go home?

I go home **because school is finished.**

Why is there no food today?

(short) **Because the shops are closed.**

Why is Yolande not at school?

Yolande is not at school **because she is ill.**

Why is the school closed?

The school is closed **because it's Christmas.**

Why is Malee so sad today?

(short) **Because her mother is very ill.**
