A hobby is an activity that we like to do regularly in our free time.

Other words for 'hobby' are 'leisure', and 'pastime'.

We say "I **practice** a hobby." Others say "I **pursue** a hobby."

In this lesson we use the word 'practice'.

We practice a hobby for pleasure or relaxation.

A hobby satisfies our personal or creative desires.

Hobbies are not about profession or career.

However often one's hobby becomes a profession later.

A trumpet player can become a professional musician and many hobby football players who are talented become professionals later.

Some people practice their hobby every day. Others only once per week or once per month.

An activity is not a hobby when you don't practice it regularly.

Very often	every day
Often	twice a week
Sometimes	once a week
Hardly ever	once a month

A hobby can be practiced alone, with 2 people or in groups.

When we talk about hobbies we use the **-ing form** (play**ing** football, windsurf**ing**, swimm**ing**).

The use of 'go', 'play', and 'do'

'Go' is used with activities that end in -ing.

Do you go swimming? Who do you go swimming with?

'Play' is used with team sports and those sports that need a ball or similar object. It is also used for activities in which two people or teams compete against each other.

Do you <u>play</u> football? Who do you <u>play</u> football with?

'Do' is used with recreational activities and with individual, non-team sports or sports in which a ball is not used.
