9. Frost:	A thin layer of ice on frozen surface.
10. Lightning:	The flashes of light that are produced in the sky during a storm.
11. Rain/rainy/raining:	Water that falls in drops from clouds in the sky.
12. Raindrop:	A single measurement of rain.
13. Rainbow:	A band of colours found in the sky after rainfall.
14. Raining cats and dogs:	Raining heavily.
15. Season:	Time of the year characterized by certain weather (winter, spring, summer, or fall (autumn)).
16. Snow, snowy, snowing:	Soft, white pieces of frozen water falling from the sky in cold weather.
17. Sun/sunshine/sunny:	Warmth and light from the sun.
18. Sunburn:	Painful red skin caused by being in the sun too long.
19. Temperature:	How warm or cold the air is.
20. Thermometer:	Instrument for measuring the temperature of the air.
21. Thunderstorm/thunder	A storm with lightning and thunder.
22. Umbrella:	A device that is used for protection from the rain and sun.
