• 8. A long thin, pale green vegetable with a dark green skin and usually eaten uncooked in salads.

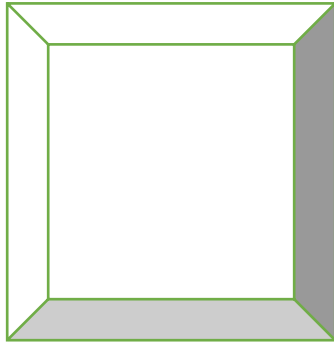
• 9. A small vegetable, red or white that grows underground and is usually eaten uncooked in salads.
